



# LOCAL RULES

### OUT OF BOUNDS (Rule 27-1 applies)

- a) A ball at rest is out of bounds only when all of
- it is outside the boundary edge of the course. In or beyond any ditch bounding the course. b)
- The course boundary, where unfenced, is defined by the line of marker posts. On or beyond the line defined by the marker posts to the right of the 1st and 13th holes; nd the left of the 13th tee whilst playing the relevant hole.
- On or beyond the line of marker posts behind d) the 2nd green and to the right of the 3rd hole.
  The wood as defined by the line of marker
- posts to the left of the 4th fairway. In or beyond the fences bounding the footpath to the left of the 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th and 8th holes
- On or beyond the line defined by the marker posts to the rear of the 7th and 9th greens.
- posts to the rear or the 7th and 9th greens. The greenkeepers' machinery shed, surrounds and other areas to the right of the 8th tee, as defined by being on or beyond the fence line bounding the house and greenkeepers' area to the right of the 8th fairway. Within the greenkeepers' area to the left of the 8th tee as defined by the line of marker posts and marked trees.
- Beyond the fence adjoining the farm to the rear of the 14th green and to the right of the 18th fairway, including the copse at the adjoining corner.
- On or beyond the line of marker posts to the right of the 18th green.
- right of the 18th green.

  On or beyond the line of white marker posts, to the right of the 16th Fairway, up to the white marker adjacent to the 17th tee.
- Any ball that comes to rest on, or is the line of play of, a hole cup cover on the green, may take free relief no nearer the hole.

#### PENALTY AREAS

All ponds, lakes and ditches within the perimeter of the course defined by red or yellow posts are penalty areas, and relief should be taken accordingly under Rule 26, except behind the 5th, 10th and 15th greens, marked by red and white posts, which require the use of the applicable dropping zones. (see Local Rule 7).

# IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS

(Rule 24-2 applies)
The bench seats, the small fences around the teeing areas, fixed signs, fixed litter bins, fixed ball washing equipment and constructions for cut grass are deemed to be immovable obstructions.

## STAKED AND TAPED TREES

(Rule 24-2a & b applies)

#### **FIXED SPRINKLER HEADS**

All fixed sprinkler heads are immovable obstructions and relief from interference by them may be obtained under Rule 24-2. In addition, if a ball lies off the putting green, but not in a hazard, and such an obstruction on or within two club lengths of the putting green and within two club lengths of the ball intervenes on whill in Wo Glab let guis of in it extends and the hole, the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may take relief as follows; The ball shall be lifted and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay which a) is not nearer the hole, b) avoids such intervention and, c) is not in a hazard or on a putting green. The ball may be changed whom as lifted. cleaned when so lifted.

#### SHELTERS, STARTER'S HUT, TOILETS, TIMBER OR STONE RETAING WALLS (TO 7TH AND 10TH TEES, AND TO THE LEFT OF THE 7TH HOLE)

These are deemed to be integral parts of the course from which there is no relief.

#### DROPPING ZONES

The dropping zones are mandatory and are to be used, on the following holes, for a ball crossing the hazard line behind the green, in the area defined by the red and white striped marker posts.

5th hole, to the right of the green 8th hole, to the left of the green.

10th hole, at the back of the green into the lake. 12 hole, to the left of the green. 15th hole, at the back of the green. 17th hole, to the right of the green. Rule 26-1c does not apply. Failure to do so incurs a two shot penalty for breach of a local rule.

#### PATHS AND BRIDGES

Relief may be taken from all artificially surfaced paths and bridges without penalty under Rule 24-2. However, relief is NOT available without penalty for that part of any path or bridge which lies within a Water or Lateral Water Hazard (Rule 26-1a-c).

#### **POWER CABLES**

If a ball strikes a power cable, the ball must be replayed without penalty.

# 10. STONES IN BUNKERS

(Rule 24-1 applies)
Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions.

#### 11. GROUND UNDER REPAIR (Rule 25 applies)

Ares of ground marked with white paint or suitable signs are G.U.R.

# NOTES

- Players MUST replace all divots, repair all pitch marks and tidy bunkers.
- If during play on the course, you cause damage, or think you may have caused damage to property either on the course or adjacent to the course, you MUST report the details to the Honorary Secretary, a Club Official or a member of the Professional Staff
- on return to the Clubhouse.

  All balls going over the course boundaries (with the exception of the footpath) are IRRETRIEVABLE. No attempt must be made

Please bear in mind that this is an undulating Golf Course with Rura Features and can be exposed to adverse weather conditions which may affect your experience. We would ask you to take extra care when walking on paths, bridges, car parks and any areas which may be wet. Please be on the lookout for any wayward golf balls and any Plant and Machinery being driven during course maintenance. Do NOT hit any golf balls in the direction of Grounds Maintenance Staff or Machinery.


